FGD's 3-on-3 Rules

- 1. High school rules will apply to the games. Any infraction of regulations will result in loss of possession of the ball.
- 2. All games must start with at least 3 players on each team.
- 3. Substitutions are unlimited, but permitted only on dead balls and made baskets.
- 4. Games will begin on the hour and ½ hour promptly. GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME! Games will be to 16 points, win by one point, or 25 min. (including a 5 min. warm-up).
- 5. We will have one VOLUNTEER official per game, with several floating officials who may step in if needed.
- 6. The team captains are expected to represent his/her team as spokesperson.
- 7. No dunking during warm-ups.
- 8. The boundaries will vary slightly from court to court. If you are unsure, check with the officials on your court.
- 9. Dukos will determine first possession.
- 10. A ball out-of-bounds will always be taken out at the top of the key. The ball must be checked by an opposing player before it is put into play from any dead ball situation. The ball must be passed into play.
- 11. Two-point shots will be counted if the shot is made behind the 19 ft. line. If fouled on a two pointer, you may shoot 2 FTs.
- 12. Each team is allowed two, 45 second time-outs; however, the clock will continue to run. On a made basket, count the basket and possession goes to defensive team.
- 13. Continuous misconduct will result in dismissal from the tournament.
 - a. Flagrant fouls, as determined by the official and solely at their discretion, will result in FT, <u>and</u> they will maintain possession of the ball.
 - b. Two flagrant fouls will result in the ejection of that player from the game, and possibly the tournament (director's discretion).
- 14. All fouls will be handles in the following manner:
 - a. On a made basket, count the basket and possession goes to the defensive team.
 - b. On a missed basket, if FT is made the ball goes to the defensive team. If the FT is missed, the offensive team retains possession.
 - c. FT will be shot after the 3rd team foul. FT count as one point.
 - d. In any FT situation, the designated shooter may choose to shoot from the FT line for one point, OR from behind the 2pt line for 2pts. If the 2pt. FT is chosen, the non-shooting team will be awarded the ball regardless of make or miss.
- 15. The ball will change possessions after the scored baskets. The ball will be taken back on each change of possession. Failure to take it back will result in the loss of any points resulting from that possession.
 - a. "Taking it back" means your entire body and both feet must be behind the 2pt. line.
 - b. Jump balls will go to the defense.
- 16. Tournament officials will reserve the right to disqualify any team for infractions of the following policies:
 - i. Use of illegal players
 - ii. Unnecessary roughness

The tournament director will decide on any situations that come up that are not covered in these rules. The director's decision is final and cannot be appealed.
